## *Championship Golf*

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The award winning Las Sendas public 18-hole Championship Golf Course, designed by the highly regarded Golf Course Architect Robert Trent Jones, II, integrates the natural landscape and offers a challenging yet playable golf experience. Practice facilities include a large driving range as well as chipping and putting greens. The pro shop is located in the public clubhouse and

provides everything from golf apparel to equipment as well as an indoor/outdoor lounge — offering spectacular views of the valley below. The golf course is now open for play as well as the clubhouse for your enjoyment. The Las Sendas Golf Course and Clubhouse are privately owned but currently allows residents of Las Sendas to enjoy preferred privileges over the public.

## *Trailhead Members Club*

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Located near the entrance of Las Sendas Mountain is an architectural masterpiece, the Trailhead Members Club, a 12,000-square-foot multipurpose facility offering community activities for all residents. The Club features Southwestern Craftsman Architecture style, with high ceilings, exposed wood trusses, and abundant natural daylight. Massive stone columns, multi-hued tile roof and soft desert blending color scheme harmonize with the surrounding lush Sonoran desert environment. Generous covered terraces and Porté Cachere provide for year round enjoyment of the great outdoors.

Elevated above the community, the Trailhead

Members Club provides the ideal location for indoor/outdoor, formal or informal gatherings and community events. Complete with the state-of-the-art Trailhead Athletic Club & Spa, Pool and Racquet Facility, Banquet and Conference Rooms with a Catering Kitchen as well as a centralized location for onsite Community Association Personnel. Residents can bask in the sweeping views overlooking the city lights from the inviting view terraces and patios surrounding the clubhouse. The golf course with its lakes and mountain ranges including Red Mountain are also clearly visible from the terraces and pool patio.

## *Boulder Mountain Swim Center, Community Parks & Tennis Club*

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The Boulder Mountain Swim Center provides multi-functional uses such as a play pool integrated into a lap area, detached children's play pool and a romantic spa with scenic vistas. Ramadas, restrooms and generous seating complete this facility. Two very large community parks, Boulder Mountain Parke and Sonoran Heights Parke, with amenities for most everyone, such as lighted basketball courts, lighted volleyball courts, large grassy play areas, softball or soccer fields for daytime play, play

stations and swing areas for children, covered ramadas for get-togethers, barbecue grills, seating areas, bicycle racks, restroom facilities and drinking fountains.

The Sonoran Hills Tennis Club consists of four club style courts including a sloped, stadium-style court and covered ramadas and seating areas for your enjoyment — truly a first class tennis arena. The Sonoran Hills Tennis Club compliments the Pool and Racquet areas within the Trailhead Members Club.

## *Walking Trails & Open Space*

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The entire community is integrated by miles of natural desert and hard surface pathways for walking, biking or rollerblading as well connecting you to all the residential communities, the Las Sendas Elementary School, The Village at Las Sendas with its dining, shops and offices as well as the community parks, swim center and tennis club.

Some of the natural desert trails lead you to intimate settings where you may encounter a lifesized statue of an individual who has made an impact on the world — or you could even take a trail to the Tonto National Forest which is Las Sendas' northern boundary. Overall the Community boasts of over 880 acres of open space.
